## ORGANIZATION OVERVIEW

Founded by Taiba Rahmani, a 14-year-old Afghan-American living in Arlington, VA, Her Craft: Stitching the Future is dedicated to empowering Afghan girls and young women by providing them with opportunities for education, skill development, and financial independence. Our mission is to sponsor one or two girls from Afghanistan every four years, depending on the revenue generated from selling their handcrafted goods, allowing them to break free from cycles of poverty and oppression. We work with girls aged 12 to 26, a particularly vulnerable group in Afghanistan due to Taliban-imposed restrictions that bar girls from school beyond sixth grade, often leaving them confined to their homes and at risk of forced marriages. Financial hardships drive families to arrange these marriages with wealthy older men abroad or, in some cases, Taliban soldiers who view Afghan women as spoils of conquest. By selling these girls' handmade crafts to a global audience, we provide them with an income to help lift their families out of poverty while preserving their cultural heritage. Our purpose is twofold: to offer Afghan girls the chance for a future free from oppression through education sponsorships in the U.S. and to equip them with skills in traditional handicrafts and business management, preparing them for success in both local and global markets.
